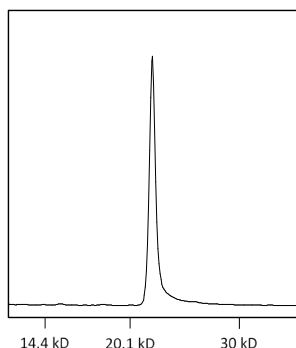

Description	Recombinant human fatty acid-binding protein 3 (FABP3) with a C-terminal histidine tag. Predicted molecular weight: 16 kDa

Product buffer solution	Lyophilized from 50 mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5; 150 mM NaCl; containing 3 % sucrose, 4 % D-mannitol and 0.01 % Tween 20 as stabilizers.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute the lyophilized protein with deionized water
Shelf life and storage	Unspecified for lyophilized product, storage at 2-8 °C. After reconstitution 1 month at 2-8°C and 1 month at -20°C.
Analyte description	The fatty-acid-binding proteins (FABPs) are a family of carrier proteins for fatty acids and other lipophilic substances. Hearttype fatty acid-binding protein (H-FABP= FABP3) is a low molecular weight cytoplasmic protein present abundantly in the myocardium. When the myocardium is injured, as in the case of myocardial infarction, low molecular weight cytoplasmic proteins including H-FABP are released into the circulation and H-FABP can be used as a biochemical diagnostic marker in the early phase of acute myocardial infarction (AMI).
