Description	Monoclonal mouse antibody, cultured in vitro under conditions free from animal-derived components.

Analyte description	In the plasma of patients suffering from disseminated intravascular coagulation (DIC) and in the plasma of patients being treated by the thrombolytic therapy, plasmin is produced by plasminogen activation and immediately forms a complex (PIC) with $\alpha$ 2- plasmin inhibitor at a ratio of 1: 1 in circulating blood. PIC in the plasma is considered important in the diagnosis of DIC, as a molecular marker for monitoring the thrombolytic therapy and so on.
